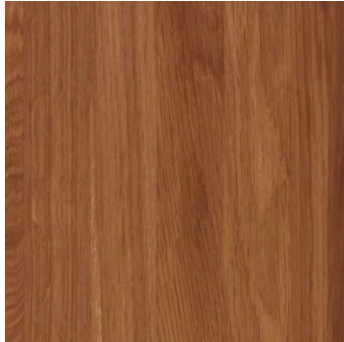
The versatile stool CIRO made of oiled solid wood and designed by Moritz Bannach perfectly reflects the sculptural design language of Bannach due to its purist geometry. The detailed and at the same time reduced form of the stool emphasizes its pure materiality as well as the handcrafted construction. The square seating surface made of Viennese netting playfully softens the rectilinear design. The striking Ciro is available in oak, black stained oak, walnut as well as Douglas fir.

Der vielseitige Hocker CIRO aus geöltem Massivholz wurde von Moritz Bannach entworfen und spiegelt in seiner puristischen Geometrie die skulpturale Designsprache von Bannach perfekt wider. Die detailstarke und gleichzeitig reduzierte Form betont das pure Material wie auch die handwerkliche Konstruktionsweise des Hockers. Die quadratische Sitzfläche aus Wiener Geflecht lockert die geradlinige Konstruktion spielerisch auf. Der charakterstarke Hocker Ciro ist in Eiche, Eiche schwarz gebeizt, Nussbaum sowie in Douglasie erhältlich.

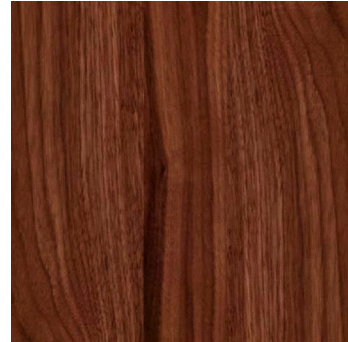

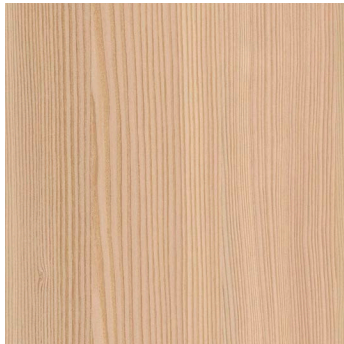
Oak | Eiche

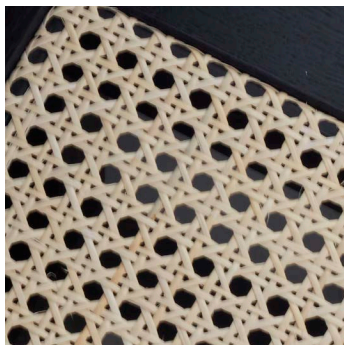

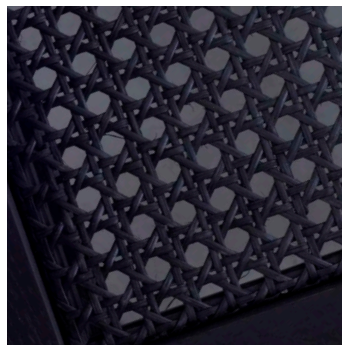
VIENNESE RATTAN MESH | WIENER GEFLECHT
